(As well it should be after finishing another nice effort.) **Pete** acknowledged **Randy Hansen** for another stellar job as Master of Ceremonies, **Yours Truly** for patience in working with the Herald, and incoming chair **Connie Wittren** for putting together a great program. **Pete** pointed out that \$66,000 came from endowments (Bozich & Hoffman), \$36,000 came from the Partners program, and \$44,000 came from the club's fund-raising efforts. **Steve Juntwait** announced an upcoming Fireside the evening of June 3, for 12 Rotarians (members only, not spouses) at **Bill Hoffman's** home.
